A NOTE FROM OUR CEO

From the founding of neverthirst in 2008 until today, this has been our heart’s cry: that the mandate of The Great Commission would advance and all peoples of the earth would be made glad, praise God, and fear Him (Psalm 67:4). In 2025, you have played a major role in advancing God’s Kingdom among oppressed peoples by providing their most basic need. HOW WE WORK

Clean and Living Water to the Unreached

We prioritize areas where the church is ready to partner to meet urgent spiritual needs and foster lasting transformation. Each water project *empowers local pastors and believers to provide hope, build trust, and share Christ with their communities.*

We prayerfully consider the most appropriate technologies at each water point, ranging from improving water quality through household water filters, to boring deep wells, to tapping mountain springs and using gravity to pipe water to an entire community.

We also work alongside trusted WASH partners to implement and sustain effective, locally appropriate water solutions.

10/40 WINDOW

At a Glance

Around the world, the greatest need for clean water exists in rural areas that are largely unreached and often hostile to the gospel. This is where and why we work — using safe drinking water as a platform for local believers to share the message of Christ. In 2025, we served in six countries across the regions of Sub Saharan Africa, Central and Southern Asia, and Eastern and Southeastern Asia.

Our work is focused exclusively on the unreached people groups within the 10/40 Window. These groups are defined by the Joshua Project as those without an indigenous community of believing Christians large or resourced enough to evangelize their own people without outside help.

Our focus will always be using the need for clean water to meet the ultimate need of every individual we serve: Christ. By platforming pastors in areas where sharing Christ is dangerous, we keep this focus central.



snakes, and wild animals. There were many times when I slipped, and my shoe would go one way, while I and the water container would go the other. Even after reaching the source, I had to wait for hours in line. I couldn't sleep properly at night. One painful memory is giving birth to my son while carrying water, a moment I will never forget.

Now, neverthirst has installed a water system at every household — this has alleviated our water crisis. I no longer have to get water or wait in line. A huge amount of time is saved, and now I can focus on animal husbandry and farming, which brings economic prosperity. In the past, I was unable to bathe when I needed to. But now, I can bathe and wash at any time, whenever needed. I would like to give all the credit to neverthirst, individual donors, and all the staff who have made it possible for us to have water in every household.

Namaste! My name is Goma, and I am 50. There are five members in my family. Our main professions are agriculture and animal husbandry. However, our income sources hardly cover our financial needs.

Unfortunately, in this village, I used to spend an entire day collecting water, walking to a faraway location 4–5 times a day. Since I have a knee joint problem, I used to carry water with a wooden bucket. The path was narrow, slippery, and through the jungle, and often I would be frightened by monkeys, jackals,

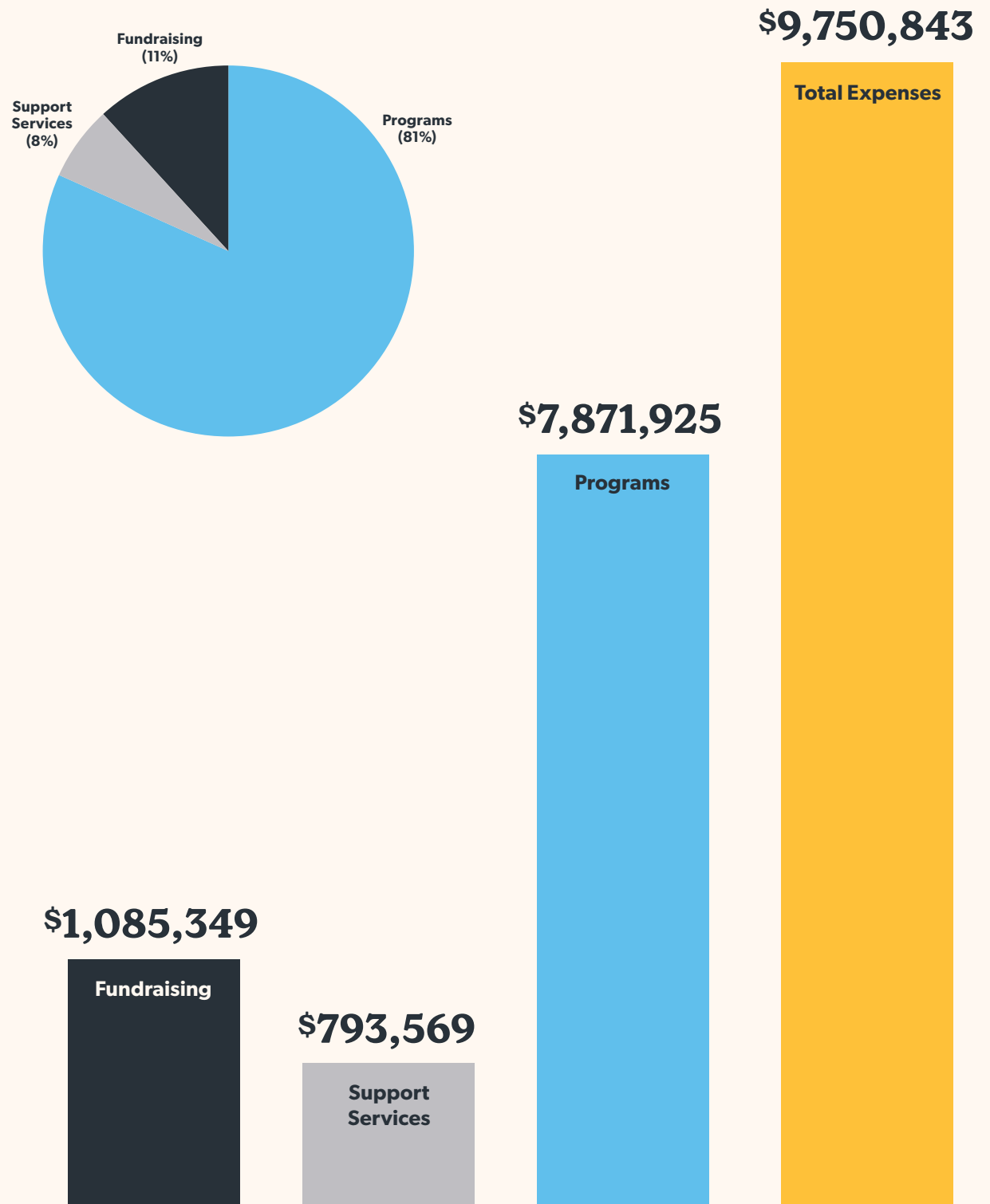
